



National Pavement Midget Championship Points and Points Fund

- I. 2022 Championship Point Season
 - a. Unless authorized by Lucas Oil Raceway, the 2022 Championship point season for the National Pavement Midget Championship will officially close upon the completion of the last scheduled Event.
- II. Administration of Points and Points Funds
 - a. Lucas Oil Raceway reserves the right to establish, maintain, compile, publish and otherwise operate and award points, Points Funds and trophies through our internal administration.
 - b. All participants agree to abide by decisions of Lucas Oil Raceway in the establishment and administration of the Points Funds.
- III. Distribution of Point Funds
 - a. Point Fund money that is won by a Competitor shall be paid by Lucas Oil Raceway to the Competitor's Car Owner.
 - b. The Car Owner and not Lucas Oil Raceway, shall be solely responsible for the distribution of any and all prize money to the Competitor, and the sole recourse of such Competitor shall be against the Car Owner.
- IV. Final Point Fund Distribution
 - a. Final point fund distribution will be based on the final Championship point standings at the conclusion of the season, and will be distributed on or before December 31, 2022.
- V. Award of Points
 - a. Points will be awarded to each eligible driver in each event according to the finishing position of such driver, as follows:
 - i. Based on the number of cars that register a qualifying time during qualifying and/or start the feature, the total events points will be established. (Ex: 24 Cars Register a Qualifying Time. 24 Total Points will be awarded to the winner).
 1. Ex: 29 Qualified Cars

- ii. Winner of feature will be awarded an additional five (5) championship points.
- iii. Fast Qualifier will be awarded two (2) championship points.

VI. Relief Driver

- a. A driver will be credited only with points earned in the vehicle in which he/she started the Race, and the starting driver will be credited with all points earned by that vehicle in that Race. To be eligible for points, the vehicle must be entered in the Event. A driver cannot receive points for more than one (1) vehicle in the Race.

VII. Ties

- a. In the event two (2) or more drivers have the same number of points (a tie), each driver will be ranked according to the greatest number of 1st place National Pavement Midget Championship finishes in the 2022 Events at Lucas Oil Raceway as of that time.
- b. If a tie still exists, the greatest number of Fast Qualifier results from 2022 will be used in the same manner until the tie is broken.

VIII. Rookie of the Year

- a. Eligibility – any driver who has not competed (qualifying or race) at any 2020 or 2021 Lucas Oil Raceway Midget race is eligible for the end-of-season Rookie of the Year award.
